STUDENTS WILL:

- successfully complete a sequential program of study that focuses on specific skills, knowledge and technology in the fields of entrepreneurship, business information technology and corporate finance.
- have opportunities to earn an Associate's degree/post-secondary credit.
- exceed the objectives of Virginia Beach City Public Schools curricula and Commonwealth of Virginia Standards of Learning tests.
- participate in job shadowing, mentoring, and/or internship programs that extend, enrich, and refine student learning and create linkages with the academic and business communities.
- complete a long-term project through an internship/mentorship experience with a culminating
 presentation in the senior year featuring an in-depth study of an issue of related concern to their
 related industry and present ideas/solutions as viable options to address the issue to a panel of
 business and community leaders.

HISTORY OF KEMPSVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

Kempsville High School is the *home of the Chiefs* and has a long-standing history and tradition of excellence in education. Kempsville High School is named after an early Virginia settler by the name of Kempe and the current building was opened in 1966. The Kempsville High School faculty and community were excited to expand the tradition of excellence in the Fall of 2016 when we opened our doors to the FIRST academy class of students. We are now operating at full capacity with close to 500 students in our academy program in all four grade levels!

There are specific courses that a student needs to enroll in, in order to satisfy the degree requirements.
